Historical Town Hall - Kronach, Germany



Kronach's historic town hall is located in an area of the city over 1000 years old. During the city's regional light festival, "Kronach leuchtet," the hall is illuminated with an innovative LED lighting concept by Illumics GbR, which incorporates Traxon's Wall Washer XB-18 RGB and Dynamic White. These high-powered fixtures enable exterior façade illumination in a dignified white or, on special occasions, in bold, saturated color schemes. The illuminated portal is flanked by two ionic detached columns on which a figure of a woman and a man are located; the armorial bearing from Prince-Bishop Johann-Philipp von Gebsattel is visible between the two figures. The various lighting schemes are controlled by e:cue's Lighting Control Engine mx (LCE-mx) and Butler XT, which includes an internal real-time and astronomical clock allowing programming of lighting show triggers based on specific dates and times, for example at sunrise or sunset. Through its creative quality, the intelligent application and professional implementation enables a seamless integration into the existing building structure.
